P23 Flood control and protection at Blanchland

Theme(s):	A: Conserve and restore river habitat, and adapt to / mitigate for the physical impacts of weather extremes and climate change.
Goal(s):	A3: Reduce risk from or control flooding.
Sub-goal(s):	A3a: Reduce risk from or control flooding from rivers.

Flood control measures at Blanchland, to include floodgates on houses, upstream leaky dams and strategic woodland planting. This is a long-term ambition with no funding attached to it yet, but the Environment Agency has funded the North Pennines AONB Partnership to provide flood gates on houses in the Wear catchment.
